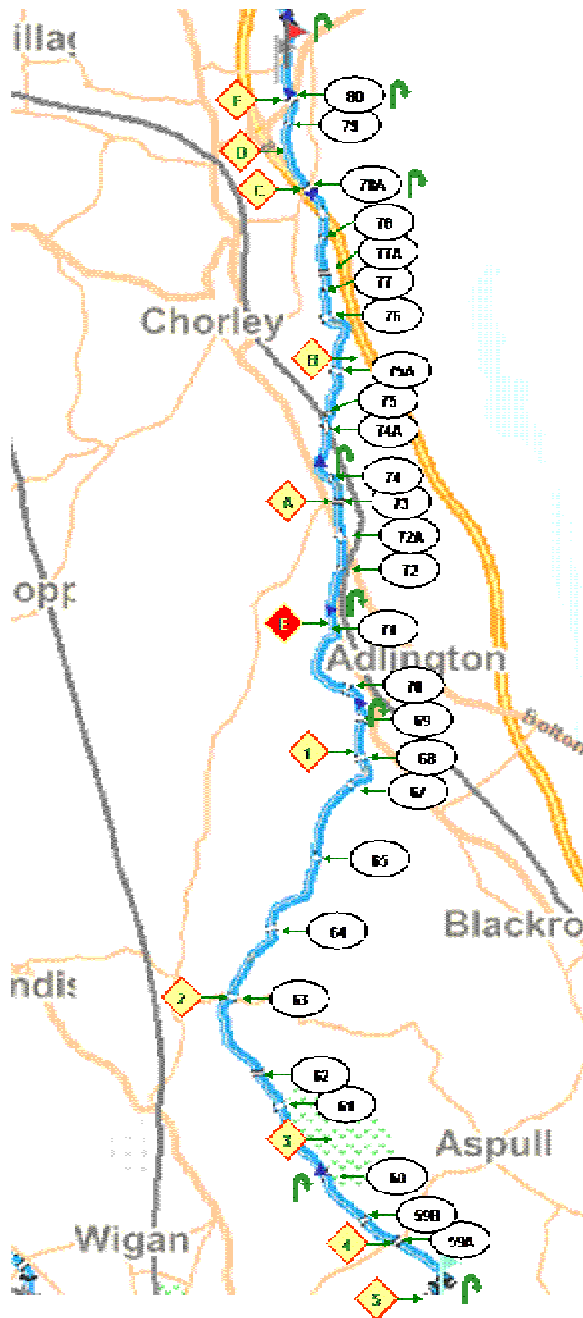


Route information and places of interest
